
## THE MOVEMENT FOR COMPASSIONATE LIVING

## TREES CHECK GLOBAL WARMING

They could even reverse it if enough forests were established! Enough land would be available if livestock farming was phased out. Trees take in CO<sub>2</sub> and store carbon in their wood. When wood is burned, CO<sub>2</sub> returns to the atmosphere. However, if forests are of mixed species, and those grown for their wood are selectively felled and saplings immediately planted in their place, the forest unit would be a permanent sink for carbon.
